

I, Jacob Sobers, of the City of Margate City (formerly called South Atlantic City) in the County of Atlantic and the State of New Jersey, having made my last will and testament, bearing date the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and eleven (A.D. 1911), do now make this codicil, to be taken as a part of the same; First, I hereby ratify and confirm said will in every respect, save so far as any part of it is inconsistent with this codicil; Second, I hereby, by my said will in item four I have given and bequeathed unto my grand-daughter Mrs. Eda Tracy a legacy of five hundred (\$500) dollars; now I hereby revoke the said legacy given to her as aforesaid, and I give and bequeath unto my said grand-daughter Mrs. Eda Tracy the sum of one (1) dollar; Third, I hereby, by my said will in item six I have given and bequeathed unto my son, Aaron Sobers, all the machinery, tools and business belonging to me at Nos. 1114 and 1116 Germantown Avenue and No. 1121 American Street, in the City of Philadelphia; now I hereby revoke the said legacy of machinery, tools and business belonging to me at Nos. 1114 and 1116 Germantown Avenue and No. 1121 American Street, in the City of Philadelphia in said item six given to him as aforesaid, and I give and bequeath unto my son Aaron Sobers the sum of one (\$1) dollar; Fourth, I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Sobers, all the machinery, tools and business belonging to me at Nos. 1114 and 1116 Germantown Avenue and No. 1121 American Street, in the City of Philadelphia.

In witness whereof, I, Jacob Sobers, the testator have to this my last will and testament and to this codicil set my hand, and seal, this eighth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven (A.D. 1911).
