Tenth: I give and bequeath to Frederick Taphen, a gold watch and chain, and to Henry Taphen Jr., a Diamond Stick Pin.

Eleventh: I give and bequeath to my nieces Annalake and Mary Schumacher all my Furniture, Bedding, Kitchen Utensils &c, to be divided among them in equal shares.

Twelfth: I do order that on my cemetery lot a suitable Foot stone of granite, and a vault for the repose of my body, built of cement and stone be erected.

Thirteenth: I give, bequeath and devise the residue of my property, both real and personal, where so ever situate and whate so the same may be, share and share alike, to my nephews and nieces.

Fourteenth: I hereby nominate and appoint my nephews Frederick Taphen and my friend Valentine P. Hofmann, as my sole Executors of this my last will and testament. Also giving them power to sell

and convey any or all of my estate, whether real, personal or mixed, and to dispose of the same in the best manner at their discretion at public or private sale, or otherwise, without the necessity of furnishing bond for this their services as such Executors.
