 Fourth: - I give my executor and trustee full power and authority to sell any or all my real estate at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as to it may seem advisable and to give good and sufficient deeds in law therefor.  
 Fifth - Any inequality in the division of my estate among my children be adjusted by the terms of the will of my husband, Walter B. Somers, made at this time, it being my intention that through the wills of my husband and myself, a fair division of our property among our children shall be made.

Sixth - I hereby nominate and appoint the Guarantee Trust Company of Atlantic City, New Jersey, executor of this my last will and testament.
