

expiration of the life interest of my said sister, Mrs Elizabeth Dickinson Beeson, the said one half of all my residuary estate real, personal and mixed, so held in trust for the said Hannah Marguerite Beeson shall be held in trust for my nephew, George Evans Dickinson, upon the terms and conditions as provided in Paragraph three of this my will until he shall have attained the age of thirty years when the said surviving trustee shall transfer, set over and assign all the said one half of my residuary estate, real, personal and mixed, so held in trust as aforesaid, unto my said nephew, George Evans Dickinson, free of all trusts absolutely. Provided, however, that if the said George Evans Dickinson dies before arriving at the age of thirty years, leaving a legal wife or child or children living, then the said one half of all my said residuary estate, real, personal and mixed shall be held in trust for such wife during her life and at her death the said trustees shall transfer, set over and assign all the said one half of my said residuary estate unto such child or children, free of all trusts, share and share alike, absolutely.

Sixth: Upon the death of the said Charles Dickinson the said one half of my residuary estate, so held in trust for him during his life, as provided in Paragraph three of this my will shall be held in trust for his widow, Mary Evans Dickinson, if she be then living, for and during the term of her natural life or until she shall remarry, and the income paid to her upon the same terms and conditions as set forth in said Paragraph three of this my will.

Seventh: Upon the death of the said Mary Evans Dickinson, wife of the said Charles Dickinson, or upon her remarriage and upon the expiration of the life interest of the said Charles Dickinson the said one half of all my residuary estate real, personal and mixed, so held in trust for the said Charles Dickinson as provided in Paragraph three of this my will, shall be held in trust for my nephew, George Evans Dickinson, upon the terms and conditions provided in said Paragraph three of this my will, until he shall have attained the age of thirty years when the said trustees shall transfer, set over and assign all the said one half interest in my residuary estate, so held in trust as aforesaid, for the said Charles Dickinson, unto my nephew, George Evans Dickinson, free of all trusts, absolutely. Provided, however, that if the said George Evans Dickinson dies before arriving at the age of thirty years, leaving a legal wife or child or children living, then the said one half of all my residuary estate, real, personal and mixed, so held in trust for the said George Evans Dickinson, shall be held in trust for such wife, during her life

and at her death the said trustees shall transfer, set over and assign all the said one half of my trust estate unto such child or children, free of all trusts, share and share alike, absolutely.

Eighth: In the event of the said George Evans Dickinson dying before he shall have attained the age of thirty years and not leaving a legal wife or a child or children, then, or in the event of his leaving a legal wife, at her death the said one half of all my residuary estate, real, personal and mixed, so held in trust for the said George Evans Dickinson, shall be held in trust for my said niece, Hannah Marguerite Beeson during her life upon the terms and conditions as provided in Paragraph three of this my will, provided, however, that if the said Hannah Marguerite Beeson shall marry and have a child or children then the said trustees shall transfer, set over and assign the said one half of all my residuary estate, real, personal and mixed, so held in trust as aforesaid unto the said Hannah Marguerite Beeson, free of all trusts absolutely.

Ninth: In the event of the failure of all the within described persons taking all my said trust estate upon the terms and conditions as within set forth it is my will that my said residuary estate shall be held in trust by my said trustees and the income derive therefrom after payment of taxes, mortgages interests and all other proper charges, to be paid over as received unto the University of Pennsylvania and the Jefferson Medical College in equal parts, share and share alike, to be used for the benefit of persons afflicted with tuberculosis, provided that my said trustees shall have complete discretion as to the manner in which the said income shall be maintained and expended.

Tenth: I do nominate, constitute and appoint my said sister Mrs. Elizabeth Dickinson Beeson, and my said brother, Charles Dickinson, to be the executors of this my last will and testament, and desire that they shall not be compelled, for any reason whatsoever to furnish bonds, either as trustees or executors. In the event of the death of either of my said trustees I authorize the surviving trustee, at his or her option, to apply to the Orphans' Court for the appointment of another trustee such as said survivor or may nominate to fill the vacancy.
