I direct my Executor hereinafter named to pay my just debts and funeral expenses as soon as after my decease, as the same can conveniently be done.

I give and bequeath unto my nephew, John S. Lehman, of Atlantic City New Jersey, my two Parker shooting guns, gunning skiff, sails and all equipment connected with said guns and and gunning skiff.

I direct my Executor hereinafter named to sell all my real estate and personal property at public or private sale for such prices and at such times as he in his uncontrolled discretion may deem best, and to make and execute all proper deeds, assignments and other papers which may be necessary in order to vest a good title in the purchaser, hereby relieving any and all purchasers from seeing to the application of the purchase money, and after my said estate shall have been converted into cash, I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to my sister Elizabeth Paynter absolutely and should she predecease me, then I give, devise and bequeath the rest residue and remainder of my estate to my two nieces, Leah Paynter and Harriet Paynter Nedraw, children of my said sister, Elizabeth Paynter share and share alike, provided they be living at my death, but if only one of them shall be living at my decease, then the survivor shall receive my entire estate.

I appoint my attorney, Samuel J. Taylor, to be the executor of this my last will and Testament.
