

Eighth-- I give and bequeath the smaller one of my two diamond rings to my granddaughter Dorothy Daly.

Ninth- I direct that my executor and executrix or the survivor shall immediately after my funeral expenses and debts are paid, pay to the New Cathedral Cemetery a sufficient amount of my money, to insure the perpetual care of my lot in the said cemetery

Tenth: I direct, unless I should do so during my life, that my executrix and executor or the survivor of them should have a monument erected over the graves of myself and husband

Eleventh: I give, devise and bequeath unto my children, Anna Daly, John Wurtz and Josephine Ryan and to their heirs and assigns in equal shares and parts, three fourths of the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real personal and mixed whatsoever and wheresoever the same may be at the time of my decease. I give, devise and bequeath the remaining one-fourth part of all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed whatsoever and wheresoever the same may be at the time of my decease to my executor and executrix and the survivor of them hereinafter named, in trust for Marie, Josephine, John Joseph and Frank Schaefer, children of my deceased daughter, May Schaefer the said trustees and the survivor of them to divide the said residue into five equal parts or shares and use the principal or interest of each each share for the maintenance and education of each of the said children as the trustees and the survivors of them may deem necessary, and further as each of the said children reaches the age of twenty one years the trustees and the survivor of them are to pay over to him or her the amount of his or her share remaining in the hands of the said trustees and the survivor of them and if any of the said Children should die under the age of twenty-one years the part of his or her share remaining in the hands of the trustees and the survivor of them shall be divided and held by the trustees and the survivor of them under the above trust for the surviving children of my deceased daughter May Schaefer.

Item-I do hereby declare my will to be, that if any person or persons to whom any estate or interest is given or limited by this my last will shall in any court or law or equity or otherwise controvert the same, or dispute or call in question the validity hereof or of any of the estates, limitations, powers, provisos, or dispositions hereby limited or given, or made, or herein contained, then and in such case the estates, interests limitations, etc., so hereby limited, etc., to or in favor of such person, or persons so controverting my said will, shall cease, determine, and be absolutely void to all intents and purposes whatsoever, so if such person or persons was or were naturally dead. AND then and from thenceforth such estates, interests, limitations powers, provisos, and dispositions shall go and belong to and be vested in the person or persons who, by virtue of my will, shall be next in remainder after the person or persons so disputing as aforesaid: Provided he, she or they shall not controvert or dispute the validity of this my will, or any of the devises, limitations, powers, provisos, or dispositions contained or hereby made. I nominate, constitute and appoint my son John G. Wurtz, and my daughter Josephine Ryan executor and executrix respectively of this my will and direct that they shall not be required to give bond and hereby authorize and empower my executor and executrix and the survivor of them to sell and dispose of all or any part of my real estate at public or private sale or sales for such price or prices and upon such terms, and conditions as to them may seem best or to the survivor of them; and to grant and convey the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof his, her or their heirs and assigns free from all liability for or on account of the application of the purchase money.
