

remarriage to receive the rents, issues and profits thereof during said term, and from and immediately after her death, or in the event of her remarriage, then from and immediately after the event of her remarriage, I give, bequeath and devise all of my said estate in this paragraph mentioned unto my children Caroline K. Speidel, Charles Wm. G. Speidel and Anna B. Speidel, in equal portions, share and share alike, to them, their heirs and assigns, forever Third. It is my will that out of the proceeds of the rents, issues and profits accruing from the devise to my said beloved wife, she shall defray the expenses of suitable maintenance and education of my daughter, Anna B., during her minority.

Fourth. In the event that it should be deemed for the best interests of my said estate that the whole or any part of my real estate should be sold, during the life-time of my said wife, then and in such case, if my said wife and all of my said three children, or the survivor of them, shall unanimously agree thereto, they, or the survivor of them, shall have power to sell and convey the whole or any part of my said real estate, upon such terms as they shall agree upon, it being my will that the proceeds of such sale shall go to my wife for life or during her widowhood, as provided in paragraph TWO and after her death or in case of her remarriage, then to my three children, in equal portions, share and share alike.

Fifth. If at the time of such proposed sale of the whole or any part of my real estate, my daughter, Anna B., shall still be a minor, it is my will that the guardians hereinafter named for her shall, with her consent, have power to convey her share or interest in said property.

Sixth. I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife, Bertha Speidel and my son, Charles Wm. G. Speidel, or the survivor of them to be the executors or executrix of this my last will and testament and guardians or guardian of my daughter, Anna B. Speidel, during her minority they to act in each instance without entering into any bond.
