

be sold by my executor either at private or public sale, at what seems to him to be the best advantage, and that the same be divided equally between my Cousin George T. Cramer of Trenton N. J., my Cousin Laura Tilton of Atlantic City N. J. and my Cousin Marie Scull of Atlantic City N. J. if there be at the time of my death any money in bank, not otherwise provided for, it shall be divided equally between the three last named Cousins, if any one of them be dead at the time of my death, then the property described in this clause shall be divided equally among the survivor or survivors.

6th I direct that my executor have placed on my monument the date of my death, and place a granite marker to the graves of my Father, Mother, Sister, husband and myself, the same to be paid for from my estate.

I hereby appoint Absalom H. Higbee, of Somers Point, N. J. to be Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
