Item. All the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situate I give, devise and bequeath unto my three daughters, Nora M. E. Collins, Mary K. Collins and Katherine M. Collins, share and share alike.

Should any of my said daughters be deceased at the time of my wife's death leaving issue her or them surviving, then such issue to take their parent's share per stirpes.

Lastly, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my two daughters, Nora M. E. Collins, and Katherine M. Collins, Executrices of this my

last Will and Testament and I hereby authorize and empower my said Executrices whenever in their discretion it may seem advisable and for any purpose whatsoever, to sell and dispose of all or any part of my real estate which I now have or may hereafter acquire either at public or private sale, for such price or prices as they in their discretion may deem sufficient, either for cash, or part cash and part credit and to execute and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers thereof good and sufficient deed or deeds and assurances in the law therefor, without any liability, on the part of such purchaser or purchasers to see to the proper application of the purchase money
