

her own personal receipt.

After the death of my said daughter, I direct that such income be paid to her daughter, Roselee Kayne, in quarterly installments during her life.

SIXTH: At the death of both my daughter and granddaughter, I give and bequeath the sum of Five Thousand Dollars to Elizabeth M. Hemperly, and the sum of One Thousand Dollars to my counsel, Robert H. Ingersoll. I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, including lapsed legacies, if any, to my heirs at law, in equal shares, per stirpes.

In case my estate, at the death of my daughter and grand-daughter, shall not be sufficient to pay the above legacies in full, I direct that the legacy of \$5000. to Elizabeth M. Hemperly shall first be paid.

SEVENTH: I give the said Guarantee Trust Company, both in its capacity of Executor and Trustee, full power and authority to sell any or all my real estate at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as to it may seem advisable, and to give good and sufficient deeds in law therefor.

I also authorize my said Executor or Trustee to invest the

funds of my estate in such securities as may seem advisable to it and for the best interest of my estate, and to retain as investments for my estate any investments that I may have at the time of my death, without any liability for depreciation in the value of the same. No purchaser at any sale made by my Executor or Trustee shall be liable for the application of the purchase money.

EIGHTH: I direct that my Executor pay from my estate whatever collateral inheritance tax there may be due therefrom without deducting the same from the specific legacies and bequests herein made.

NINTH: If any of the beneficiaries named in this will shall take any steps to prevent the probate of the same or to contest said will or any part thereof, or to do any act whatsoever to prevent the carrying out of the terms of this will, such beneficiary shall be deprived of all interest whatsoever given hereunder, and I do expressly revoke any legacies, bequests or provisions made in behalf of any such contesting beneficiary, in case such action is taken.

TENTH: I nominate and appoint the Guarantee Trust Company of Atlantic City, New Jersey, Executor of this, my last Will and Testament, and do direct that Robert H. Ingersoll, Esq., shall be retained by my Executor as counsel in the settlement of my estate.
