BE IT REMEMBERED that I, FRANK SCHANZ, of the City of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby make and publish this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time made.

IMPRIMIS: I will and direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses shall be fully paid and satisfied by my Executor hereinafter named, as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

ITEM: I give and devise unto my adopted daughter, JESSIE E. SCHANZ, my home situate No. 28 S. Rhode Island Avenue, in the City of Atlantic City, State of New Jersey, absolutely and in fee simple.

I also give and bequeath unto my said adopted daughter, JESSIE E. SCHANZ, all of my household goods and furniture, clothing, jewelry and other personal effects, absolutely.

ITEM: I direct my Executor hereinafter named to sell and convert into cash, all of the rest of my real estate, as soon as conveniently may be done after my decease, and for that purpose, I hereby authorize and empower my Executor hereinafter named, to sell and dispose of any of my real estate, either at public or private sale for the best price that can be obtained therefor, and to sign, seal, execute and acknowledge all the necessary deeds or other assurances to the purchasers thereof in fee simple, without any liability on the part of the purchaser or purchasers to see to the application of the purchase money.

ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my Executor hereinafter named, the sum of Fifty thousand dollars, (\$50,000) IN TRUST NEVERTHELESS, to invest and keep this fund safely and securely invested, and to pay the entire net income thereof unto my adopted daughter, JESSIE E. SCHANZ, for and during the full term of her natural life, and from and immediately

Unto the PHILADELPHIA TURNGEMEINDE I give and bequeath the sum of Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) IN TRUST NEVERTHELESS, to keep this fund safely and securely invested, and to pay, apply or use the entire net income of this fund, to or for the aid or assistance of any of its poor and needy members.

Unto my sister, WILHELMINA S. GILL, I give and bequeath the sum of Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) absolutely.

Unto my sister, CAROLINE LENNON, I give and bequeath the sum of Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) absolutely. Should my said sister, CAROLINE LENNON, die previous to the death of my adopted daughter, Jessie E. Schanz, then I give and bequeath the said sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) unto the LANCKENAU HOSPITAL in the City of Philadelphia, for the purpose of founding a free bed in the said Hospital.

Unto the PHILADELPHIA LODGE OF ELKS NO. 2, I give and bequeath the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) absolutely, to be added to the Charity Fund of the said Lodge.

I direct that the above Trust Fund of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), shall be paid to my said Executor in full, and without abatement as to the other legacies hereinafter given.

ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my faithful employe, WILMER STEARN, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) absolutely, provided that he remains in my employ until the time of my death.

ITEM: I give and bequeath unto MINNIE JOERGGER, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) absolutely.
