The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden Thomas B. Elvins, Administrator of all and singular the goods and chattels, and credits of Michele Cipriano, deceased, shall well and truly administer the moneys arising from the sale of any lands, tenements or real estate of the said Michele Cipriano, directed by the order of the Orphans' Court of the County of Atlantic to be sold, according to law, and further to make, or cause to be made a just and true account of his administration, within twelve months from the date of the above obligation, and the surplus of money which shall be found remaining upon the account of such sale or sales (the same having been first examined and allowed by the Orphans' Court of the County or other competent authority,) shall distribute and pay unto such person or persons as is, are, or shall be by law entitled to receive the same, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
