

Atlantic County Surrogate's Court.

In the matter of the Estate of Lucien B. Gosson deceased. Bond

Know all men by these presents, That we Leabella R. Gosson of Mays Landing, Allen B. Endicott of Atlantic City, N. J., and Mordecai S. Endicott of Washington, D. C. are held and firmly bound unto the Ordinary or Surrogate General of this said State of New Jersey in the sum of forty thousand dollars lawful money of the United States to be paid unto the said The Ordinary or Surrogate General as aforesaid, my successors or assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made up and discharge, with here, executors and administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents. Sealed with four seals and dated the eighteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seven. The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bond in Leabella R. Gosson Administratrix of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of Lucien B. Gosson deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Leabella R. Gosson, or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Leabella R. Gosson and the same so made, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the registry of the Probate Court in the Secretary's Office of this State, or into the Surrogate Office of the County of Atlantic, at or before the expiration of three calendar months from the date of the above written obligation, and that the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of his death which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of the said Leabella R. Gosson, or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Leabella Gosson, do well and truly administer according to law, and further do make or cause to be made a just and true account of her administration within twelve calendar months from the date of the above written obligation, and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judges of the Orphan's Court of the county, or other competent authority, shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as is or shall by law be entitled to receive the same and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will or testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor or executrix therein named, or any other person or persons, do exhibit the same into the said Surrogate Court or the Surrogate's Office of the County of Atlantic making a request to have it allowed and approved, if the said Leabella R. Gosson being therein required, do readily and deliver the said letters of administration (appellation of such testament being first
