

in the westerly line of Michigan Avenue at a point fifty-five (55) feet northwardly from the northwest corner of Caspian and Michigan Avenues; thence (1) westwardly parallel with Caspian Avenue to a ten feet wide alley, ninety (90) feet; (2) northwardly along the easterly line of said alley and parallel with Michigan Avenue, twenty-five (25) feet; (3) eastwardly and parallel with Caspian Avenue to the westerly line of Michigan Avenue ninety (90) feet; (4) southerly along the westerly line of Michigan Avenue, twenty-five (25) feet to the place of Beginning, it being lot number twenty-six (26) in section number ten (10) as shown upon the map or plan aforesaid. Subject, however, to the following covenant, condition and restriction: No portion of the main body of any building to be erected upon the lot hereby conveyed, shall be built within fifteen feet from the west line of Michigan Avenue, and this covenant, condition and restriction shall attach to and run with the land; which covenant, condition and restriction has been imposed in pursuance of the same general plan, and may be enforced in the same manner as hereinafter provided relative to the sale of liquors.

Your petitioner therefore requests the aid of this court in the premises, and prays that an order may be made in manner and form as required by law, requiring the persons interested in said lands, tenements, hereditaments and real estate, to appear before this court to show cause why so much of the above described lands, tenements, hereditaments and real estate whereof the said Harry E. Conover, deceased, died seized, should not be sold as will be sufficient to pay the residue of the debts of said intestate.
