Atlantic County Orphans' Court.

In the matter of the Removal from the State
of property of Otto M. Hirschfeld, a Minor. } Order.

It appearing from the petition of David Hirschfeld, filed herein,
that said petitioner resides in the City of Hartford, State of
Connecticut; that he is the Guardian duly appointed by the
Probate Court for the District of Hartford, State of Connecticut, of
the person and property of Otto M. Hirschfeld, a minor, residing
in said City and State aforesaid and it further appearing
that the said Otto M. Hirschfeld, minor as aforesaid is
entitled to personal property situate within this County and
State, to wit: A bequest of a diamond ring, valued at Two
Hundred and Fifty Dollars, given to the said minor by the
last Will of Mathilda Snyder, deceased, duly probated before
the Surrogate of the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey,
on the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred
and six; and said minor is further entitled to a legacy
of Fifteen Hundred Dollars which by the terms of said will is
given to the said David Hirschfeld as Trustee for said
minor; which bequest and legacy are in the hands of
the Guarantee Trust Company and Jacob Silverman, the
duly qualified Executors of said will, and proof being made
to the satisfaction of the court by a certificate of the Clerk
of the Court of Probate for the District of Hartford, State of
Connecticut, duly authenticated according to the acts of
Congress, that the said David Hirschfeld, Guardian as
aforesaid, has given adequate security as such Guardian,
in double the amount of the value of the aforesaid bequest
and legacy, over and above the value of the property of said
ward, in the place of his residence, and it further
appearing that due notice of this application has been
given to the Guarantee Trust Company and Jacob Silver-
man, Executors of the last Will and Testament of
Mathilda Snyder, aforesaid, in whose custody the
said legacy and bequests are, and the court having
investigated the matter and it appearing to the
satisfaction of the court that it is for the interest of
the said Otto M. Hirschfeld ward as aforesaid, that said
Guardian and Trustee be permitted to remove the said
legacy to which the said ward is entitled, as aforesaid,
from this State.

It is thereupon on this Fourteenth day of November, one
thousand nine hundred and eight, ordered that the said
David Hirschfeld, Guardian and Trustee as aforesaid, be
and he is hereby authorized to demand, sue for, collect
and receive said legacy to which the said ward, Otto
M. Hirschfeld, is entitled as aforesaid, and remove the same
to the place of residence of himself and ward, and it is
further ordered that the delivery, transfer and pay-
ment of said legacy and bequest by the said Guarantee
Trust Company and Jacob Silverman, Executors as aforesaid,
to the said David Hirschfeld, Guardian and Trustee as
aforesaid, shall be a legal discharge and acquittance for
the same.
