Beck for sale
The order to show cause made in this matter on the first day of December A. D. 1909
having been advertised and returnable February 16th 1910 at which time said court
was regularly adjourned until February 17-1910 at some higher place and the court
having heard and examined the allegations and proofs of William Beck, executor
of the estate of Louise Beck, deceased, and of the parties interested and it appearing
on full examination, that the personal estate of Louise Beck, the said executrix, is
not sufficient to pay her debts, and that there is a deficiency amounting to the
sum of One hundred and forty eight dollars and forty six cents, and that the
said William Beck, executor aforesaid, has applied all the personal estate that
has come to his hands.

It is thereupon on this seventeenth day of February in the year one thousand
nine hundred and ten, ordered, that the said William Beck, executor aforesaid,
sell the following tracts of land whereof the said Louise Beck died seized
to wit:

All that certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate, lying and being
in the city of Egg Harbor City in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, known
and designated on the master plan of the city of Egg Harbor City, a copy of which is
filed in the office of the Clerk of the County of Atlantic Building Lots No 2 and 3 in
Block No 525 bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south
east side of St. Louis Avenue, one hundred feet northeasterly of Agassiz Street, thence
running northeasterly along the said side of the said Avenue, two hundred feet,
and extending in length or depth southeasterly, one hundred and fifty feet,
keeping the said breadth in parallel lines and at right angles with the said
Avenue, to the southwest side of a back street, containing thirty thousand square
feet, to raise the aforesaid sum of One hundred and forty eight dollars and forty
six cents in the payment of the debts of the said decedent and that after making
such sale that the said William Beck report the same to this court for its approval
and confirmation.

And it is further ordered, that before selling the aforesaid lands, the said William
Beck, executor aforesaid, shall first enter into bond to the Ordinary, with
condition, according to the statute in such case made and provided, in the sum of
eight hundred dollars, with two or more sufficient sureties, to be approved by this
