 Now, therefore, the Court doth, by virtue of an act entitled "An act concerning minors, their adoption, custody and maintenance (Revisions of 1902)" approved April 2nd, 1902 and the several facts stipulated in the petition and amended thereto, Order, Adjudge and Decree that the prayer of the said petition be and the same hereby is granted, and that said Frank Magro, minor child of the said Nicholas Magro shall hereafter be known by the name of Charles George Siskian; and the Court doth hereby declare and adjudge that from the date of this decree the rights, duties, privileges and relations heretofore existing between the said Frank Magro and his mother the said, Nicholas Magro shall be and are in all respects at an end, excepting the right of inheritance; and further, that the rights, duties, privileges, and relations, between the said Frank Magro and the said Charles G. Siskian and Coronia Siskian, his parents by adoption, are and shall hereafter be the same, including the right of inheritance, as if the said Frank Magro had been born to the said adopted parents in lawful wedlock, except only as otherwise provided in the said act of the legislature above mentioned.
