I was born in Italy (not known)
on the 26th day of September, anno
Domini 1872; I now reside at Hammonton, N. Jersey
I emigrated to the United States of America from Naples, Italy
on the vessel* Saledonia; my last
foreign residence was Jesso, Italy

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III
King of Italy
of which I am now a citizen; I

arrived at the port of New York City, in the
State of New York on or about the 23rd day
of June, anno Domini 1896; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
SO HELP ME GOD.
