occupation Tailor, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion sandy, height 5 feet 7 inches, weight 132 pounds, color of hair Auburn, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Kharof Russia, on the 10 day of Oct, anno Domini 1883 I now reside at 945 Baltic Ave Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Rotterdam Holland on the vessel Rotterdam; my last foreign residence was Kharof Russia

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Nicholas II Emperor of all the Russias, of which I am now a ~~citizen~~ subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York on or about the 27th day of Dec, anno Domini 1905; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:

HELP ME GOD.
