I, Edward Thomas Johnson, aged 49 years, occupation farmer, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion light, height 5 feet 5 inches, weight 130 pounds, color of hair light brown, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Portsmouth England on the 11th day of August, anno Domini 1864; I now reside at Edwood New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool England on the vessel Adriatic; my last foreign residence was Portsmouth England

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George V King of Great Britain and Ireland of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 3rd day of June, anno Domini 1881; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
