I was born in Causa Santa Italy on the 5th day of November, anno Domini 1871; I now reside at Pleasantville New Jersey (Give number, street, city or town, and State.) I emigrated to the United States of America from Naples Italy on the vessel S. S. Elerra; my last foreign residence was Causa Santa Italy. It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 16th day of August, anno Domini 1901; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
