I, Alfred Ernest Howard Cairns, aged 23 years, occupation glass-worker, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion fair, height 5 feet 8 inches, weight 144 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes brown, other visible distinctive marks none.

I was born in Toronto Canada on the 27th day of October, anno Domini 1892; I now reside at Mays Landing, New Jersey, R.F.D. #2.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Montreal Canada on the vessel By rail (New York Central); my last foreign residence was Montreal Canada.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George 5th King of Great Britain and Ireland, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 15th day of August, anno Domini 1908; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
