I was born in *Sesso, Italy* on the *2nd* day of *February*, anno Domini *1899*; I now reside at *Hammonton, New Jersey*

I emigrated to the United States of America from *Naples, Italy* on the vessel *does not remember*; my last foreign residence was *Sesso, Italy*; I am *not* married; the name of my wife is _____; she was born at _____

and now resides at _____ It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state; or sovereignty, and particularly to *Nector Emmanuel 3rd King of Italy* of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of *New York City* in the State of *New York* on or about the *25th* day of *November*, anno Domini *1902*; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein: SO HELP ME GOD.
