I emigrated to the United States of America from Naples Italy on the vessel St. Mary Church; my last foreign residence was Casoli Italy; I am un married; the name of my wife is Angiolina Bellone was born at Piscia Italy and now resides at Laudisville New Jersey.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel Third King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of New York City in the State of New York, on or about the 7th day of June, anno Domini 1910; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
