I was born in Lidonia Italy
on the 13th day of January, anno Domini 1884. I now reside
at 13th Street / Hampton New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Calermo Italy
on the vessel Santa Anna; my last

foreign residence was Lidonia Italy; I am un married; the name
