I, John Cori, aged 35 years, occupation Laborer, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color White, complexion Dark, height 5 feet 4 inches, weight 150 pounds, color of hair Black, color of eyes Brown. other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Audonia Italy on the 13th day of January, anno Domini 1884. I now reside at 13th Street, Hammonton, New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Calenzano Italy on the vessel Santa Anna; my last foreign residence was Audonia Italy; I am married; the name

of my wife is Maria Cori; she was born at Audonia Italy and now resides at Audonia Italy

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel

3rd King of Italy, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York City, in the

State of New York, on or about the 27th day

of June, anno Domini 1913. I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
