I, Harry Suedod Kwon Feinburg, aged 41 years,  
occupation Operator, do declare on oath that my personal  
description is: Color White, complexion Dark, height 5 feet 4 inches,  
weight 135 pounds, color of hair Dark Brown, color of eyes Brown  
other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Roma Russia  
on the 15th day of March, anno Domini 1879; I now reside  
at #6 Adams Row Atlantic City New Jersey  
(Give number, street, city or town, and State)

I emigrated to the United States of America from London England  
on the vessel Venedon  
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given); my last

foreign residence was Roma Russia; I am not married; the name  
of my wife is Anna; she was born at Roma Russia  
and now resides at #6 Adams Row Atlantic City N.J.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Present Government  
of Russia, of whom I am now a subject;

polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy, and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
