Saturday TED Talks

On Saturdays since January we have been presenting TED talks. TED stands for Technology, Entertainment, and Design; they are found online and are presented by the Rolex Company. There are more than 1500 talks and more are still being produced. The talks are short videos, most being about 5-15 minutes, and are inspiring as well as educational. Our twice-monthly program consists of three talks grouped by topic with a short discussion after each.
