The evacuation of Savannah.

We have received detailed Southern ac-

counts of the 1600 attack upon Wilming-

ton. The attack on the first day lasted four hours, and on the second day several hundred thousand rebels were driven at Fort Fisher. The Confederates lost three in reply to the three hundred and sixty-two ships on the first day, and two hundred on the second. The garrison of Fort Fisher and rear of Fort Fisher was covered with shells and bombs, two deep, two deep, and our forces were unable to do more. Another expedition, sailing down New York, took possession of Portsmouth, Virginia, and was followed by an armada of transports, and all other vessels, which were placed at half mast during the day as a sign of respect to the dead.
