### Store Keepers Liable To Heavy Fines For Having False Weights.

Continuing its warfare on unscrupulous dealers and obtaining that from consumers to get their money's worth when they go to market, the inspectors connected with the State Department of Weights and Measures, William L. Wadsworth, are putting into effect a supplemental law by the last legislature to the effect of increasing the efficiency of the scales.

The new law provides that any dealer who is found to be using false weights or scales shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$50 and not more than \$100.
