The alarm signals are as follows: 1—short blasts, East of Fire Station; 2—short blasts, West of Fire Station; 3—short blasts, South of Fire Station; 4—short blasts, West of Fire Station. All blasts are to be preceded with one long blast as an alarm of fire.
