JUDGE SHINN PUTS NEW CLAMPS OVER ATLANTIC CITY LIQ

HOLDS FOUR SUNDAY LAW VIOLATORS AS HOSTAGES FOR OTHERS.

NO SABBATH OASES FOR RESORT.

Court Adopts Novel Method of Dealing With Offenders and Forbids Them To Re-engage In Liquor Business—Auto Thief Sent To State Prison—More Pleas Taken.

Hostages were taken by Judge L. C. Shinn Wednesday last from the ranks of Atlantic City liquor dealers for the proper observance of the Sunday excise laws.

"I am going to defer sentence until August 23," said the Court, "on condition that you do not seek renewal of your license, engage in the liquor business directly or indirectly, and that you do not re-engage in Atlantic City liquor business until you have given promise to suspend, entirely, the conditions were met, only deferring the same."

Convicted Friday of last week of obtaining automobile belonging to his employer, Thomas G. Rose, Jr., alias Edward Wallis, was sentenced by Judge Shinn to serve a term of not less than one month nor more than three months in the State Prison at Trenton.

Barian Alexander, colored, who was convicted of breaking and entering a dwelling in Atlantic City, was sentenced to six months in the State Prison.

James Brown, who pleaded guilty to larceny and gave bail, was placed on probation for two years and fined fifty cents during that period.

Two pleas to indictments arising from the Grand Jury's breaking and entering, and a mystery entered a plea of guilty to a charge of larceny.

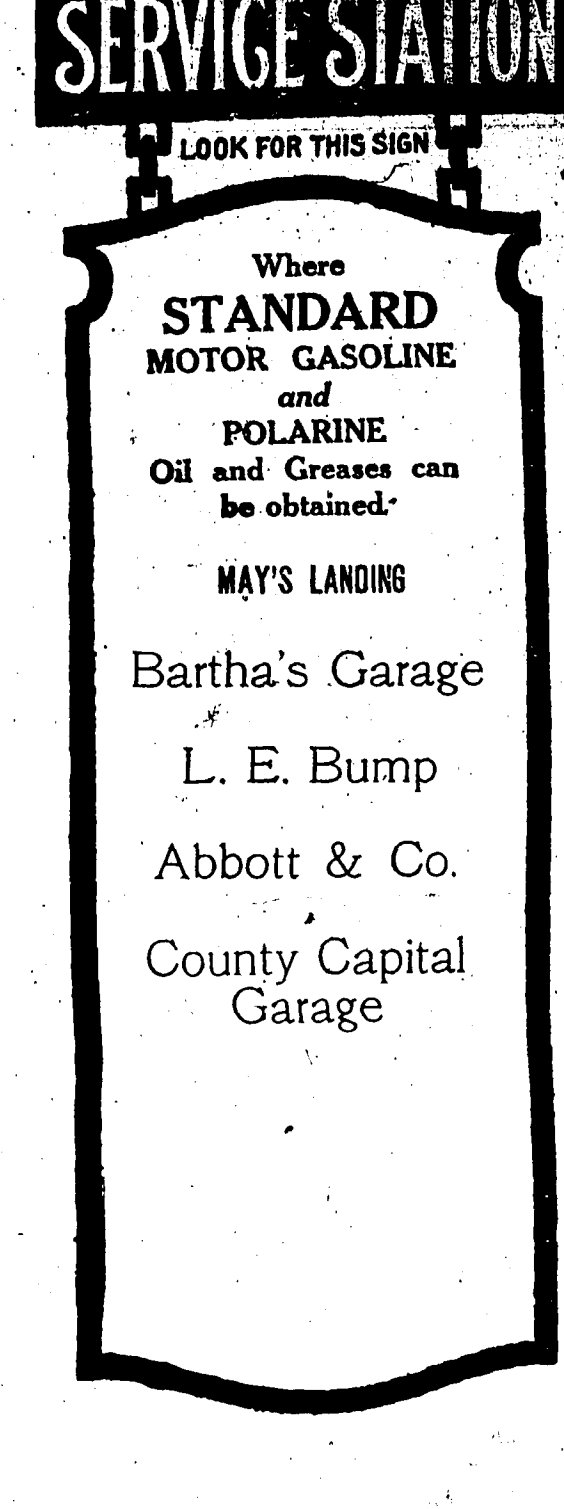
