JURY ACQUITS BARNETT OF MURDERING JOHN LALLY

Latter's Death Outcome Of Drunken Brawl In Saloon.

"Not guilty," was the verdict returned Tuesday by the jury which tried Thomas G. Barnett on an indictment charging him with the murder of John J. Lally, who met his death during a drunken brawl in the saloon of Agnes Delany, on the afternoon of August 31 last. It took the jury but ten minutes to reach its decision and the defendant was immediately ordered released by Supreme Court Justice C. G. Black, who presided at the trial.

GUILTY OF MANSLAUGHTER NEGRO GETS LIGHT SENTENCE

Commander Had Provocation For Fight With Mother's Landlord.

After deliberating for three and a half hours Monday the jury which tried Benjamin Comander for the murder of Levi Taylor, at his home, 104 1/2 North Avenue, on July 26 last, returned a verdict of guilty of manslaughter. Judge Charles C. Black imposed sentence Tuesday, not less than two or more than ten years in State Prison.

In passing sentence Justice Black said: "After a fair trial the jury has pinned the crime of self defense on the state and you are guilty. The Court thinks that there are extenuating circumstances in your case. You fought, as you believed, in defense of your mother and her home. The crime you committed was done in a fit of temper that passed you and the sentence of this court is that you shall serve a term of not more than ten years and not less than two years in State Prison at hard labor."

Commander's own story of the crime, corroborated in the main by other witnesses, was as follows: "While I was eating supper, the little girl came to where I was standing and told me that my mother wanted me. After I had finished I went around to see what she wanted. I found her sitting in a chair with her hands on the table and a white cloth covering her face. She was crying and she said that Taylor had taken her child and put her upstairs. I went upstairs and got them and had already put one on my things when I heard a noise from the stairs and then came down. I was looking over the door when I saw Taylor suddenly Taylor grabbed the door and pushed it down. He caught me by the throat and began to kick and hit me. I fought back. When I saw the knife, it was lying either on the table or on the floor, I took it when we both tried to get it. I got it. I cut him several times. I can't tell how many or where. He ran out toward the street still struggling. "He hit me on the breast and a sort of skin came down over my eyes and I don't remember clearly what happened after that. I think that I did throw dishes at him but I don't think that I kicked him."

NEW JERSEY WORKMEN LOSE THIRTY MILLIONS



TAX MAP FOR TOWNSHIP WILL COST THOUSANDS

Another Hardship Imposed By Democratic Legislature.

Tax Assessor Harry Jenkins was summoned before the Atlantic County Board of Taxation Saturday last and notified that Hamilton Township, in accordance with the act passed by the 1913 Legislature, under Democratic control, will have to get a new tax map, of which the estimated cost will be \$2,000. This will be a heavy burden to the township, and the assessor has been endeavoring to get by the imposition of this hardship, in which he has been seconded by other township officials, for the option seems unanimous that such a map is an expensive luxury and is not needed. Assessor Jenkins so informed the Board, but they declined to see the matter in this light. In fact, they insisted that unless the township got busy and secured the map it would be done by the Board and assessed against the district. Hamilton Township has over seventy thousand acres of land and the area would have to be surveyed, platted, owners designated, etc., by competent surveyors. The estimate of \$2,000 may be exceeded and what is more, it will have to be raised by direct taxation on the township unless ways can be found out of the dilemma. The only opportunity to escape the imposition of this burden seems to be to get the matter deferred until after the next session of the Legislature in the hope that the law will be changed. Imposition of this expense would jump the local tax rate to more than \$1.00 per \$100 valuation.
