 Be it remembered that I Daniel C. Champion of the Township of Cogharcove in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey do think meet to make this my last will and testament while I am sound in mind and mental faculties -
 First I order all my just debts and funeral charges to be paid, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife bequest all my real and personal Estate all notes of hand and all books debts and all my right in lands, I further order hereto my wife to pay a legacy to heres Champion my Mother John Champion my Brother and Hannah Somers my sister, the sum of two Dollars each to be paid when the notes is collected that I hold against Aaron Somers deceased. I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend John Pennington of May Landing Soc and only Executor to this my last will and Testament, revoking all former Wills made by me ratifying this and no other to be my last will and Testament. Whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two 1842 signed sealed pronounced and delivered by Daniel Champion to be his last will and Testament in us two sign our names as Witnesses
