



Application having been made by Mary
Foley for probate of the last will of Jane Boyle
deceased, and Letters Testamentary thereon, and the
Surrogate having inquired into the circumstances
and taken proof, and being satisfied of the genu-
ineness of the Will produced, the validity of its
execution and the competency of the testatrix and
the probate of said Will not having been con-
tested and it appearing that the testatrix died
more than ten days ago, it is, on this Twenty-
third day of September A.D., 1892 adjudged that
the instrument offered for probate in this matter is
the last Will and Testament of Jane Boyle deceas-
ed, and the same is hereby admitted to probate;
and it is ordered, that Letters Testamentary be issued
thereon to Mary Foley the Executrix named in
said Will who may qualify thereunder.
