Sixth:— I give devise and bequeath to my Son Charles P. Bowyer the Lot of ground with the Brick building with store therein and known as number Two hundred and thirty-one Market Street Camden, having a front on the north side of Market Street square of twenty feet and extending northward of that width along the west side of Third Street eighty seven feet: Also a small piece of ground on the westerly side of the aforesaid described Lot Beginning seventy four feet northward from the north side of said Market Street square and extending northward thirteen feet and east and west twenty feet and all profit income and advantage that may result therefrom from and after the decease of my said Wife Jane Bowyer to have and to hold the same to him the said Charles P. Bowyer his heirs and assigns from and after the decease of my said Wife to his and their use and behoof forever.

Ninth:— I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Mary A. Mc Allister wife of Joseph McAllister all of my real estate situate on Maryland Avenue, Atlantic City Atlantic County, New Jersey: Also my Lot of ground with the brick house thereon erected and known as number One hundred and nine north Third Street in the said City of Camden, and all profit income and advantage that may result therefrom from and after the decease of my said wife Jane Bowyer to have and to hold the same to her the said Mary A. Mc Allister, her and their use and behoof forever.

Tenth:— I give devise and bequeath to my James B. Bowyer, the lot of ground with the brick House thereon erected and known as number One hundred and thirteen Pearl Street: Also the Lot of ground with the house thereon situate on Oak Street One hundred feet southward from Chestnut Street all in the said City of Camden and all profit, income and advantage that may result therefrom from and after the decease of my said Wife Jane Bowyer to have and to hold the same to his the said James B. Bowyer, his and their use and behoof forever.

Lastly:— I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my two Sons the said John Bowyer and Charles P. Bowyer the sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament
