Adams, Administrator with the will annexed, of the estate of Rachel S. Adams deceased. Now, Therefore, if the above bounden Frank C. Adams Administrator as aforesaid, do make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Frank C. Adams or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Frank C. Adams and the same so made, do exhibit into the

Surrogate's Office of the county of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, at or before the expiration of three calendar months from the date of the above written obligation, and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other goods, chattels and credits, of the said deceased, at the time of her death, which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for the said Frank C. Adams do well and truly administer according to law; and further do make or cause to be made a just and true account of his administration, within one year from the date of the above written obligation; and all the net and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judges of the Orphans Court of the county, or other competent authority; shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as is, are or shall by law be entitled to receive the same; then the above obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
