

Will of Albert Beyer.

In the name of God. - Amen. -

I, Albert Beyer, of Egg Harbor City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, being of sound mind and memory and understanding, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner following, that is to say:

First - It is my will and I do order, that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied, as soon as conveniently can be, after my decease. Item, I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Maria Magdalena Beyer all my property and estate, real and personal, provided, that she does not marry again after my decease.

But in case my beloved wife Maria Magdalena Beyer should marry again after my decease, I give, bequeath and devise to her only so much and only such a part of all my real and personal property and estate, as she is entitled to by her right of dower at common law; and the remainder of all my real and personal property and estate I give and devise in this case to my children, to be divided between them in equal parts; and in case any of my children should die under the age of twenty-one years, and without lawful issue, then I order, and my will is, that the portion herein devised or bequeathed to such child or children, shall be equally divided between the remainder of my children, in equal portions, share and share alike.

Lastly I appoint my loving wife Maria Magdalena Beyer executrix of this my last will and Testament, and guardian to my children, during their minority.

I witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal the seventeenth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine.

Signed, published and declared by the said Albert Beyer, to be his last will, in the presence of us, who were present at the same time, and subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the testator
