Will and Testament.

In the name of God, Amen.  
I, Andrew Schwartz's, of the City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, being of sound mind and memory, do make publick and declare this my last will and testament.

After the payment of my debts and funeral charges, I give devise and bequeath all the residue and remainder of my property and estate real and personal in the manner following,

1. I give and devise one third thereof to my son John absolutely and forever.
  2. I give and devise one other third to my son William absolutely and forever.
  3. I give and devise the remaining third to my daughter Josephine Herzog, absolutely and forever.
- I hereby constitute and appoint my son in Law, Charles Herzog the Executor of this my last Will and Testament without Bond.
