Dehly the sum of One hundred dollars - and To my cousin, May Jane Mc Funnell, the sum of One hundred dollars.

Item, I give devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, unto my sisters in law Mary Boland and Alice Boland to be divided equally between them, their heirs and assigns.
