VIII. Eighth: I give and direct that the sum of Five Hundred Dollars be set apart for the maintenance and education of my son Harry W. Barstow until he attain the age of eighteen years.

IX. Ninth: I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth A Barstow, all remaining estate, both real and personal, in whatever it may consist, or wherever situate to have, hold, receive, use and enjoy the rents issues, interests and profits thereof during the term of her natural life, if she so long remains my widow; and from and after her decease, or her again marrying, I give devise and bequeath my said estate unto such child or children as I shall leave or have living at the time of my decease, and to their heirs and assigns forever, and the representatives of any deceased child to have the share of his, her or their parent. The above bequests to my said wife is hereby made and to be by her received in lieu of her right of dower in my estate.

X. Tenth: I do give to my Executors herein after named and to the survivors or survivor of them full power and authority to grant, bargain, sell and convey any or all of my lands to any person or persons in fee simple or otherwise, at public or private sale, at such times and upon such terms as they shall think fit.

XI. Eleventh: I appoint my wife Elizabeth A. Barstow guardian of such of my children who have not attained their majority.

XII. Twelfth and Lastly, I do hereby name constitute and appoint my wife Elizabeth A. Barstow, my daughter Georgie Barstow and my son Charles W. Barstow, Executors of this my last Will and Testament without security.
