

from the date of Probate of this will one-half of the appraised value of said personal property I direct that possession of said boarding house and personal property be given to my son William J. Wilson and that he be entitled to the issue and profits thereof pending the payment of said sums.

Third, I direct my Executors to pay to my son William J. Wilson the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as soon as possible after my decease, which sum shall be deducted from his share of the insurance money hereinafter disposed of.

I direct my Executors to pay to the Church of the Ascension of Atlantic City for such use as its proper officers may designate the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

I direct my Executors to pay to Gertie Hatch upon her eighteenth birthday the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Fourth: - I hereby direct my Executors to collect the insurance policies upon my life amounting to Thirty Seven Hundred Dollars and to pay from said fund all my just debts and funeral expenses, the sums above mentioned and the mortgage of One Hundred Dollars upon the property on New York Avenue devised to my son Thomas K. Wilson, and to divide the balance of said money between my two sons Thomas K. and William J. Wilson share and share alike.

The mortgages on the properties devised in this will excepting the one of One Thousand Dollars before mentioned are not to be considered debts within the meaning of this section but are to remain upon said properties until paid off by my sons.

Fifth: - I give and bequeath my driving bay mare "Lady May" to my son Thomas K. Wilson if he desires to keep her if he does not then I give her to my brother William Kelly.

Sixth: - I request my Executors, if my two sons will consent thereto, to sell the Philadelphia property which will become my sons upon my death and to properly distribute the proceeds therefrom to my said sons.

Seventh: - I hereby constitute and appoint The Atlantic Safe Deposit and Trust Co. and Thompson Iron Executors of this my Last Will and Testament.

Eighth: - On second page the words upon the condition that he pay to his brother Thomas K. Wilson

the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) within five years from the date of Probate of the will erased before the execution of this will.

I, Mary A. Wilson do make and publish this Codicil to my last Will and Testament in manner following, to wit,

First, I do hereby ratify and confirm my said Will in all respects except as the same may be revoked or altered by this present codicil.

Second, I hereby revoke that portion of the Third Item of said Will which directs my Executors to pay to the Church of the Ascension of Atlantic City the sum of Two hundred Dollars, and I direct that such sum or amount shall become a part of the residuary of my estate.

Third, I hereby revoke that portion of the Third Item of said Will which directs my Executors to pay to Gertie Hatch upon her eighteenth birthday the sum of One hundred Dollars, and I direct that such sum or amount shall become a part of the residuary of my estate.

Fourth, I direct that the Executors of my said Estate place over my grave a suitable stone or monument within two years from
