

Subject to the deduction of the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000) from the share of Annie E. Danenhower, and of the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) from the share of Georgena Malan, as is hereinafter provided, it is my will and I direct that my executor and trustee, hereinafter named, having converted my estate, real and personal, into cash, or having converted into cash so much thereof as in his judgment shall be best to so convert as hereinbefore provided, shall divide all of the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real and personal, into five (5) equal shares or parts, and to pay over one such equal share or part unto each of my five daughters, Annie E. Danenhower, Emma S. Rosell, Ida M. Bonsall, Myra Hart, and Georgena Malan, first, however, deducting from the share or part which would be paid to my daughter, Annie E. Danenhower, the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000) which is the sum I consider the said Annie E. Danenhower and her husband, Daniel Danenhower, are indebted to me. The said sum of \$4000, deducted from the share of Annie E. Danenhower, I give and bequeath in equal parts share and share alike, to my daughters, Emma S. Rosell, Ida M. Bonsall, Myra Hart, and Georgena Malan, to be received by my said four daughters in addition to their equal one-fifth parts or shares of the residuary estate, and also first deducting from the share or part which would be paid to my daughter, Georgena Malan, the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) which is the sum in which I consider the said Georgena Malan to be indebted to me. The said sum of \$200 deducted from the share of the said Georgena Malan, I give and bequeath in equal parts, share and share alike, to my daughters, Emma S. Rosell, Ida M. Bonsall, Myra Hart and Annie E. Danenhower, to be received by my said four daughters in addition to the equal one-fifth shares or parts of the residuary estate. And in the event that any of my said daughters shall depart this life leaving issue her surviving before my death, it is my will and I direct that the issue of such deceased child or children shall take and receive among them such sum or sums share or shares, as such deceased daughter would have received under this will, if living at the time of my death. I nominate, constitute and appoint LeRoy C. Bonsall the executor of this my last will and testament, and the trustee for the purposes therein set forth. In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Thirtieth day of December, in the

year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine (1899).
