

each of my children shall have an equal interest and share in my estate.

I empower my Executors to collect the income and rents arising from my estate and after the payment of interest taxes repairs and other necessary expenses to apply the same or as much thereof as may be necessary to the payment of the amounts directed to my Wife and daughters.

It is further my will that should any of my children die before the death of my Wife Lavinia Barnett without leaving lawful issue the survivors or survivor of such child or children shall be entitled to such share or shares absolutely and in case there should be two survivors such share is to be equally divided between them. if any of my children should die before my wife Lavinia Barnett and not have married then I direct that their share in my estate shall be equally divided among my surviving children.


I further direct my Executors to pay to my brother Frank Barnett now residing at Atlantic City, N. J. the sum of One thousand dollars - also to pay Mercy Ward of Nottingham, England the sum of Five Hundred dollars. I also direct my Executors immediately upon proving this Will to transfer Twenty shares equal to Two thousand Dollars par value, of my stock in the G. & F. Barnett Company to William Barnett & Samuel E. Carver each.

I direct my Executors to invest all money and income of my estate after paying the above named amounts and annual amounts in good securities for the benefit of my estate.

I appoint and constitute my wife Lavinia Barnett, Samuel E. Carver, Henry W. Scattergood, Irene J. Barnett and Lavinia E. Barnett my executors of and trustees under this my last will and testament giving them full power to use their discretion in settling up my estate in accordance with my desired expressed I hereby authorize them to sell all or any part of my real estate at public or private sale or sales and to make good and sufficient deed or deeds therefor to the purchaser or purchasers thereof without any liability on the part of such purchaser or purchasers to see to the application of the purchase money or moneys and freed also from the trusts herein contained.


