The whole proceeds of the estate shall be divided as soon as possible, at latest five years after my death and after the death of my wife, in thirty equal parts and in the following manner turned over to the latest named persons respectively institutes.

Legate I $\frac{3}{30}$ (Three-thirtieth) shall my brother Louis Bonn receive, if not more alive, shall the amount be paid to his daughter, Emma, married to Crater Lutz.

Legate II $\frac{4}{30}$ (Four-thirtieth) my brother Julius Bonn shall receive, if not alive, the amount shall be paid to his legal heirs but the distribution to his heirs shall be in such a manner that his daughter Emily shall receive a further part in the same, if five children of my brother Julius are alive the amount shall be divided in six equal parts, Emily shall receive two sixths and the other children one sixth each.

Legate III $\frac{1}{30}$ (one thirtieth) my niece Emily (daughter of my sister) married to August Grunz shall receive, the payments shall as long as her husband lives be made to him, if he should be not be more alive, then my niece shall be entitled to receive the legacy.

Legate IV $\frac{1}{30}$ (one thirtieth) the executor shall use to buy the brother of my wife, Rudolph Tauberbey in a home, a surplus if any shall be deposited for him in a good saving bank, if possible under the condition that he shall be entitled to draw annually only a certain amount.

At the final distribution of the estate the amount for securing a home for him shall be deducted from the legacy.

Should Rudolph Tauberbey die before the death of my wife, this legacy is null and void and the amount shall be credited to the Reserve fund.

Legate V $\frac{4}{30}$ (four-thirtieth) the German Society of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia shall receive to assist poor widows and orphans.

Legate VI $\frac{7}{30}$ (Seven-thirtieth) the board of directors of the United Free German Sunday School Association in Philadelphia shall receive; the amount shall be distributed to each school, according to the number of pupils, which each school had on their record on the day of my death.

With this legacy combine the desire that all the schools belonging to the said United Free German Sunday School Society may introduce in the upper classes the Reader "Sittenslehre" published by the Publications Committee of the German Independent Congregation in Philadelphia & F. Huck, A. Lutz, & Bonn, B. & Stephan.

Perhaps the stereotyp. plates which are in the possession of the German Independent Congregation in Philadelphia could be acquired at a reasonable figure.

In this manner these books could be produced at a very moderate price.

According to the report the following schools are belonging today to the Union:

- (1) German Independent Sunday School Society.
- (2) German Sunday School Society of Philadelphia.
- (3) Socialist School Society.
- (4) Free German Sunday School Society Frankfurt.

If to the day of my death other free German Sunday School Societies have joined said union, they shall be included in this legacy.

Legate VII $\frac{1}{30}$ (one thirtieth) David Koegel Junior shall receive besides the legacy designated to him in Legacy § 4.

This legacy VIII shall be paid under the same condition as the Legacy § 4. (Paragraph four) # 600.

Legate VIII $\frac{1}{30}$ (one thirtieth) Anna Wender my former scholar and for many years teacher at the free Sunday School of mechanics Bund shall receive.
