Barrett do well and truly administer according to law; and further do make or cause to be made, a just and true account of his administration within twelve calendar months from the date of the above written obligation; and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration, the same being first examined and allowed of by the Judges of the Orphans Court of the County, or other competent authority, shall deliver and pay such person or persons respectively, as is, are, or shall, by law, be entitled to receive the same.
