Bickley of Riverton, New Jersey, widow of Lloyd W. Bickley deceased. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Anna R. Milton of Pittsfield Massachusetts, wife of William F. Milton. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Susan R. Cannell of the city of Philadelphia, wife of J. Skirwith Cannell. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Lucy Parkcoat Smith of the city of Philadelphia wife of H. Cavalier Smith. - One seventh thereof to my son Daniel Leeds Miller of Lyons Farms, Union County, New Jersey. - One seventh thereof to my son Horace W. Miller of Richmond, Virginia. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Rachel Rydall Ravens of the city of Philadelphia, widow of Franklin Lanier Ravens. And I have advanced the sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty dollars (\$2680) to my son Daniel Leeds Miller for business purposes I direct that this sum be deducted without interest from his share of my estate hereinbefore bequeathed to him.

As I have also advanced on various occasions different sums of money to my son Horace W. Miller I direct that the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) be deducted without interest from his share of my estate hereinbefore bequeathed to him.

All presents given to me at any time by any of my seven children are to be returned to them (All my silver, glass, china, furniture and household goods I leave to my seven children to divide amongst themselves as evenly as they can. My clothing and what little jewelry and lace I may have I leave to my five daughters to divide amongst themselves.

I appoint the Girard Life Insurance Annuity and Trust Company of Philadelphia my executor of this my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of April 1907.
