Fourth. I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved sister Mary E. McCoy, Executrix of this my last will and testament, and direct that no bond or security be required of her as executrix.

Fifth. It is my will that no other action shall be had in the County Court in the administration of my estate than to prove and record this will and to return an inventory and appraisement of my estate and list of claims.

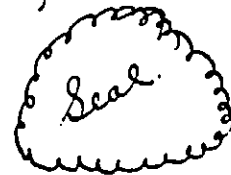
