Thirteenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to the Ocean Methodist Episcopal Church at English Creek, Atlantic County, New Jersey, the principal to be invested in good securities or deposited in reliable banks and trust companies, the interest only to be used for repairs and improvements and insurance in and upon said church and cemetery; and said fund to be known as the "Rev. Peuben Babcock Church Legacy to the Ocean Methodist Episcopal Church at English Creek." I give this as a thank offering to the Allwise and Ever Merciful Father, whose tender love, and watchful care has guided my feet in the path of peace and happiness, which path winding through the many years I have trodden with increasing and more abiding faith.

It was at a special service at the above-named church, when I was but twenty years old, that the experience of this new peace and happiness was born in my life, and though the years have come and gone the recollections of that event have grown stronger and sweeter, as I have lived and learned more of the Blessed Spirit which seeks to guide and bless our lives.

Fourteenth - I give, devise and bequeath unto the niece and nephews of my wife, as follows; To Polly A. Cordery Five Hundred Dollars; to Elizabeth Babcock daughter Three Hundred Dollars; to Annie Cordery Peck and Sarah Lyton Cordery the sum of One Hundred Dollars each; to each of the children of Mr. J. R. Fleming the sum of One Hundred Dollars; to each of the children of William H. Fisher that may be living at the time of my death a like sum of One Hundred Dollars, trusting that these little gifts may remind them of my interest in them and of my desire for their welfare and happiness.

Fifteenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the Local Preachers Association of the Camden, New Jersey, District.

Sixteenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the New Jersey Training School at Vineland, New Jersey, for the benefit of feeble-minded.

Seventeenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the Methodist Episcopal Hospital of Philadelphia Pennsylvania located at No. 2301 South Broad Street, Philadelphia, Pa. I was once a Director of this Institution but because of impaired health which made it impossible for me to give the duties of the office proper attention I was forced to discontinue my pleasant relations.

Eighteenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the Atlantic City Hospital.

Nineteenth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the Murer Memorial Home for old people of Atlantic City, New Jersey. I wish more attention might be given to the care of the old and helpless.

Twentieth - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the New Jersey Childrens Home Society, located at Trenton, New Jersey.

Twenty-first - I give, devise and bequeath the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the Childrens Home of Atlantic City, New Jersey.

Twenty-second - As all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, and wheresoever situate, I give, devise and bequeath one-half thereof unto my beloved wife Hannah C. Babcock, her heirs and assigns forever, and the remaining one-half I give, devise and bequeath unto my executors and trustees hereinafter named, in trust, to invest and re-invest the same and pay the interest, issue and income hereof semi-annually or otherwise if practicable unto my said beloved wife, Hannah C. Babcock, during the term of her natural life, if she so long remain my widow, and immediately upon her death or re-marriage, the same together with any accumulations of interest thereon shall by my executors and trustees be equally divided among my brothers, and sisters, nieces and nephews, and grandnieces and nephews, living at the time of the death or re-marriage of my said wife, and distribution, per capita, share and share alike.

In event of any of the beneficiaries being minors at the time of the distribution the share of such minor or minors shall by my executors and trustees be placed in a reliable trust company to the credit of such minor or minors to be paid by such trust company to such minor or minors as they respectively reach the age of twenty-one years of age.

Item 1. Except where herein expressly provided all gifts and bequests are personal and if the beneficiary named shall not be living at the time of my death the legacy shall lapse and pass as a part of the residuum of my estate.

I nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Hannah C. Babcock; I must Cordery, her brother, Peuben C. Babcock Jr., my nephew; and Charles C. Babcock, Councillor at Law, my second cousin, Executors and Trustees of this my last will and testament, without bond, having the most implicit confidence in all of them to properly discharge their duties and hereby invest them with full power to sell any or all of the real estate of which I may die seized at such time or times, for such sum or sums, and upon such terms and conditions as in their judgment shall be best for the interest of my estate and to make, execute and deliver good and sufficient deed or deeds unto the purchaser or purchasers for the same, thereby relieving the purchaser or purchasers from all liability for the application of the purchase money, all personal bequests shall be binding upon all of the real estate of which I may die seized.

In case of the death or disability of any said executors and trustees to act, the survivors shall act until the number is reduced to two, at which time the two surviving shall name a competent relative of mine, or a trust company to constitute the third executor and trustee.
