Be it remembered that I, Jacob Allesmann of the City of  
Altoona, Blair County, Pennsylvania being of sound mind  
memory and understanding do make my last will and  
testament in manner following; that is to say: -

After and subject to the payment of all my just debts  
and funeral expenses, I give devise and bequeath all of  
my personal property of every description to my wife,  
Mrs. Margaret C. Allesmann - absolutely. I also give to my  
said wife the use of or the rents for income from the  
"Hotel Royal" at corner of 10th Avenue and 13th Streets Altoona  
Pa. until the same shall have been sold as hereinafter  
authorized, and after the sale of my real Estate including  
said "Hotel Royal" I give and bequeath unto my said wife  
from the proceeds thereof the sum of Fifteen Thousand  
Dollars in addition to the bequests hereinbefore mentioned.  
Second, I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter  
Mrs. Louisa Storm and to her heirs and assigns forever  
all that house and piece of ground which she now  
occupies in the 7th Ward of the City of Altoona Blair County  
Pennsylvania, and being the half the double house and  
lot of ground at corner of 3rd Street and Walnut  
Avenue in said City of Altoona, and the remaining <sup>or</sup>  
other half of said double house and lot of ground I  
give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Mrs. Mollie  
Carlin for and during the term of her natural life, and  
at her death I give <sup>devise and</sup> bequeath the same to her children  
or the survivors of them share and share alike forever.  
Third, I hereby empower and authorize my Executors

hereinafter named to sell at public or private sale all  
of my remaining real estate within two years after  
my death, and after the payment of all my just  
debts, funeral Expenses and the costs of settling my  
estate I give and bequeath the net proceeds thereof  
to my widow and children as follows:  
To my widow Mrs. Margaret C. Allesmann - Fifteen Thou-  
sand Dollars being the sum heretofore mentioned.  
To my son Theodore Allesmann the sum of One Hundred  
Dollar.

To my daughter Mrs. Cardinal McCarry the sum of One  
hundred Dollars  
To my daughter Mrs. Louisa Storm, one third of the  
balance, To my son William Allesmann - one third of the  
balance, and to my daughter Mrs. Mollie Carlin one  
third of the balance of said real estate. The share of  
said balance falling due to my said daughter Mrs.  
Mollie Carlin I direct my Executors to invest safely for  
the use of my said daughter and to pay the interest  
thereon to her during her life and at her death to  
pay the principal sum to her children share and  
share alike.

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my wife  
Mrs. Margaret C. Allesmann and Edmund Shaw Esq. of  
Altoona to be the Executors of this my last will and  
testament.
